

## Methods used and studies identified in rapid evidence assessment update in 2017

### Summary of methods use in update


Searches were conducted in June 2017. PsycINFO, MEDLINE, CINAHL and ERIC databases were searched using the same search terms used in 2012:

((parent\* N3 educat\*) or (parent\* N3 program\*) or (parent\* N3 train\*) or (parent\* N3 promot\*) or (parent-train\*) or (parent-educat\*) or (parent-promot\*)) and Australia

Only English language papers available online were included. Studies and additional data were not sought from authors. An in-depth analysis of study bias, quality and effects was not undertaken.
