Virtual Groups

This resource is a summary of the video titled "Virtual Groups" in this series.

Providing an opportunity for families and individuals to join a virtual group can have many benefits. Families experiencing difficulties in accessing transport, feeling isolated or with restricted access due to public health orders have the opportunity to learn, connect with your service and connect with their community. With some careful planning and considerations, virtual groups can be very successful - good preparation is key!

Virtual group principles

- Consider the applicability of the content is it safe to share over the virtual platform or is there • practical content that cannot be adapted
- Decide on a time when most participants can join and keep time of groups shorter it can be harder • to concentrate for longer periods of time over a virtual platform
- Engage with group members individually to discuss what they can expect, how to deal with technical • difficulties and how the facilitator can be contacted

Deciding the focus and purpose of the group will help you choose the platform:

- Education focus information sharing
- Social and connection
- A group that involves children
- Therapeutic groups will need a more secure platform •

Use your Group Facilitation skills :

- Setting up well be clear and explicit •
- Cameras on or off •
- Gently invite contribution •
- Manage the group dynamics •
- Address safety concerns
- Consider if your group requires a co-facilitator
